THE IDEAL LONG SLEEVE JERSEY.

Fleecy, warm and comfortable can describe the Long Sleeve Thermal Jersey. It features an extreme anatomic cut like the Team Jersey and a full YKK Vislon® zipper for easy on/off. The collar is high and the sleeves extra long to keep you warm in cool conditions.

As all good cycling clothing should, the Thermal long-sleeve jersey is decidedly more comfortable while on the bike than off – hunch over and raise your arms forward and you're rewarded with a hyper-anatomic garment that feels like it's been sprayed on. The snug cuffs cover your wrists just right, the lightly elasticized waist lies just above the crease of your thigh, and the neck is tight enough to keep cold air out but without feeling restrictive.

The brushed Thermoflex material capably traps warm air and is admirably breathable so you won't clam up during a hard workout. Without any proper windproofing bits added in, though, it's best to restrict the Thermal LS jersey to temperatures around 12°C and above. The fuzzy interior feels good against your skin too, which is a good thing since the tight fit makes it tough to add anything but a sleeveless or short-sleeved base layer underneath.

1. Warmer fabric for excellent warmth and wicking.
2. Extended length sleeve for comfort when riding.
3. Elastic waistband to avoid jersey riding up.
4. Covered front zipper for maximum graphic application.
5. Three rear pockets.
